



Hello Shady Lane Village Veterans! I would like to thank Shady Lane

Village resident, James Tebeau, Lot 1063 for sending me his picture and a short service story to share in our newsletter this month. James' name will be added soon to our Veterans Honor Wall.

James served four (4) years in the Air Force, 1964-1968. Three of those years were spent in England and France. He returned to McDill Air Force Base and after only month on American soil, he was placed on Temporary Duty Assignment. He had hoped that he would be reassigned to a base in Japan, however as luck would have it, he was sent to Kunsan Air Base. Kunsan is located on the west coast of the South Korean peninsula bordered by the Yellow Sea.

During his assignment at Kunsan, James lived in a tent, with the wind chill hitting -30 degrees. With the frigid temperatures the men had to dress like Eskimos to stay warm. They had no days off while in Korea. He eventually got Currier duty, that included Japan. James left this assignment in June 1968 and was discharged July 8th, 1968.


