PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

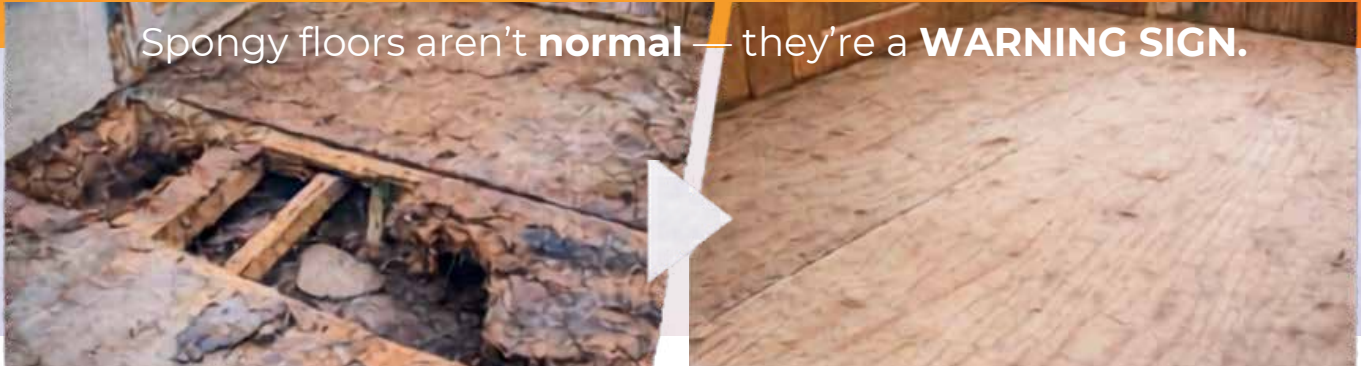

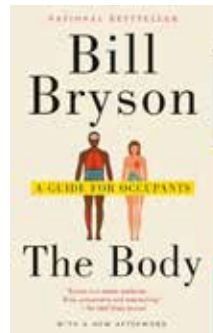
