Celebrating the New Year around the World

1. United States – Times Square Ball Drop. Millions watch the glowing ball descend at midnight
2. Spain – Eating 12 Grapes at Midnight. One grape for each chime of the clock for good luck in the coming year.
3. Japan – Joya no Kane (Bell Ringing). Buddhist temples ring bells 108 times to cleanse negative emotions
4. Brazil – Wearing White for Good Luck. People wear white and jump seven ocean waves for prosperity.
5. Scotland – Hogmanay & First Footing. The first guest after midnight should bring gifts (coal, whisky, bread) for good luck.
6. Denmark – Smashing Plates. People throw old dishes at friends' doors to symbolize affection and a fresh start.
7. Italy – Eating Lentils. Lentils symbolize coins and wealth for the coming year.
8. Greece – Hanging an Onion & Cutting the Vasilopita Cake. An onion symbolizes growth; a hidden coin in the cake brings good luck to the finder.
9. Philippines – Displaying Round Fruits. Round shapes represent coins and wealth; many wear polka dots too.

10. Germany – BleigieBen (Lead Pouring). Melted lead dropped in cold water forms shapes used to predict the year ahead.
11. Russia – Burning Wishes. People write wishes on paper, burn them, and drop them into a glass of champagne to drink before midnight.
12. China – Luna New Year Firecrackers. Huge celebrations with lanterns, lion dances, and firecrackers to ward off evil spirits.
13. France – Grand Feasts (Le Reveillon). Champagne, oysters, and lavish late-night meals welcome the New Year.
14. Mexico – Walking with Luggage. People walk around the block with suitcases to invite travel in the years ahead.
15. South Africa – Throwing Old Furniture Out the Window. In some area, tossing old items symbolizes letting go of the past.
16. Thailand – Water Festival (Songkran). Although celebrated in April, people throw water to wash away bad luck.
17. India – Lighting Oil Lamps. In some regions, lamps are lit to bring light and luck into the New Year.
18. Ecuador – Burning Effigies (Ano Viejo). People burn dolls symbolizing the old year to drive away bad energy.
19. Turkey – Sprinkling Salt at Midnight. Sprinkling salt in the doorway brings peace and abundance.
20. Colombia – Eating Three “Magic” Potatoes. One peeled, one unpeeled, and one half peeled under the bed – each predicts finances for the year.

SCAM  ALERTFamily Scams

Scammers are good at **pretending to be someone that they're not**. They try to trick you into thinking **a loved one is in trouble**.

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. **But it's all a scam**.

Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's **important to keep it secret**. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions**. They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

Slow down. Verify.


