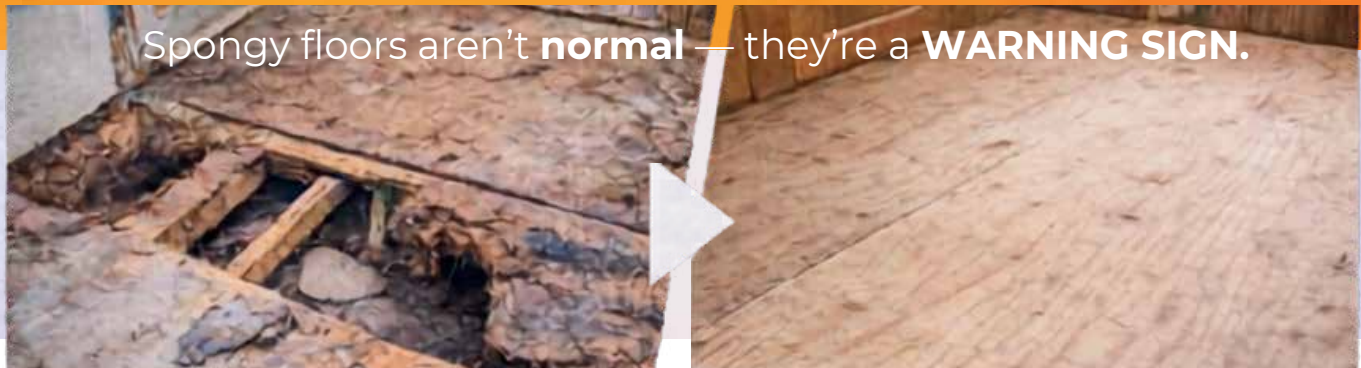
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complacent again. Let us stay united. Remember their sacrifices.

The Artisans Group is now accepting registration for Glass Classes for the upcoming season. We will be accepting email registration for any of the below listed Glass Classes.

Your email (addressed to the appropriate POC for registration as listed below) should include:



1. The glass class you are interested in

4. Indicate if you are a new student or have glass cutting experience from previous classes

In order to cover the cost of supplies and equipment, fees will be assessed as indicated for each class below. All class fees are due at the start of class, with the exception of Fused Glass (which is payable upon pickup of finished projects). As always, participants must also be a member of the Artisans Group--\$5.00 annual dues to be paid the first day of class; this is a onetime fee if you are registered in multiple artisan classes.

Business during the months of June and July this year was typical of business during summer months. During these two months this year, we sold 6 houses while last year we sold 7 for the same two-month period. This year we sold 4 lots, while last year for this same period of two months, we sold 1. The average price of homes during this two-month period is \$157,000. Average price of lots is \$6,667.

Since January 1, 2026, LaCasa Real Estate has brokered the sale of 41 homes. Eighty-one per cent of these homes (33) were sold by our sales associate and broker. Eight or nineteen percent were sold by an outside agent. The total sale price of these 44 homes sold was \$5,304,200.00 with an average sale price of \$129,370.

We anticipate business traffic to increase over the next few months. Of course, a hurricane free season would do wonders for the sale of homes and lots.

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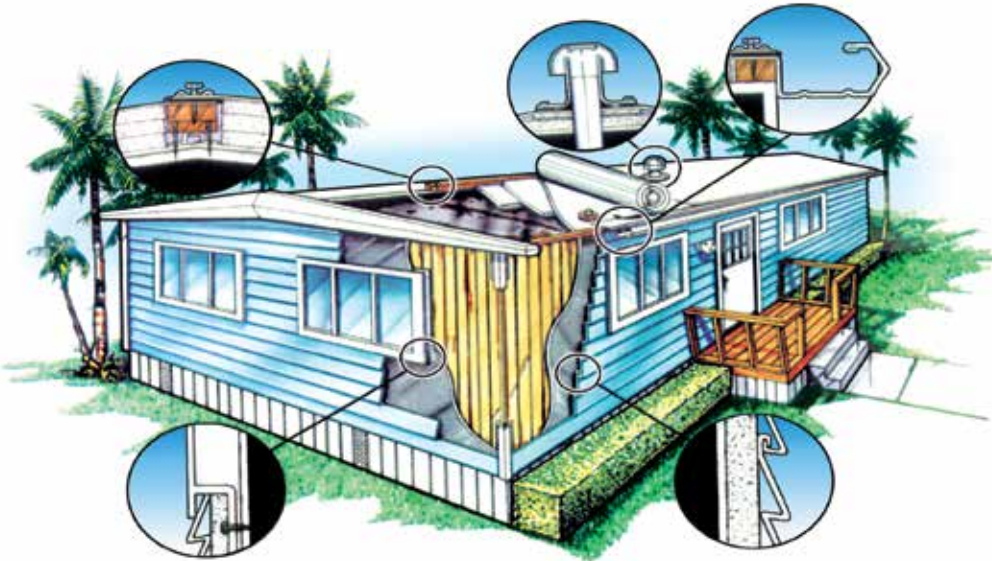

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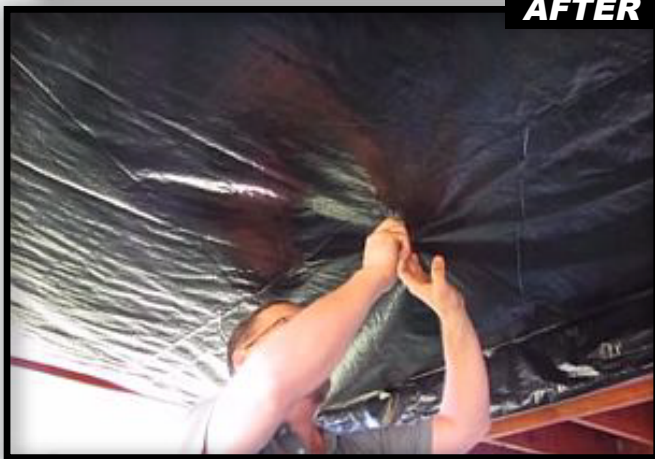
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
