We've had a ton of activity here in the community during the summer, and as we prepare for another fall season, here is a quick recap of some of the improvements of the community:

Current Project Status:

Irrigation Project Updates – Work began on August 24, 2026. Estimated completion October 31, 2026

Bocce Court awning updates – Awaiting County Approval

Perimeter Fencing – Scheduling mid-September

Asphalt replacement – Completed

Ring Central – Completed

Sound system for Ballroom – Scheduled last week in August and in final installation setup.

Solar lighting – Work scheduled to begin mid-September. Lighting around the entire perimeter of the lake and Aylesbury Lane

Veterans wall – Completed

Sod Replacement for homes along Wellfleet – Completed

Discussion of additional Golf Cart Parking – Currently in discussion

Security Cameras – Complete, cameras installed at the WWTP, Dog Park, Clubhouse and all rooms, RV Area

I would also like to take this opportunity to introduce a new way of paying your monthly lot fees. You can now pay your monthly fees by credit card if you have a resident portal account! Any resident interested in utilizing the resident portal to pay by credit or debit, in addition to our new credit card processing, you can also set up payment arrangements, in the event you have issues and you need to stretch a payment. This can now be done through the resident portal, and we encourage any resident who is interested, to stop by the office for your own login information. We encourage all our residents to take advantage of this new feature in paying your monthly amounts.

Also, if you are looking for a safe and convenient place to store your RV, we do offer on-site RV storage at a convenient location. For more info - stop in the office.

As we enter September, I would also like everyone to review your Hurricane plans. As we all know, this is the time of years where storms become more frequent. We recently held our 2026 Hurricane preparedness meeting for the community which provides some helpful information related to our community and Sarasota County. 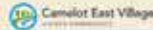
