The Board and Management would like to extend our many thanks to the residents for your continued support, and the effort put forth by the many volunteers who have made us the envy of many communities. It has not escaped our vision that without you this park would be just a place, but because of you, Horizon Village is a destination! As baseball fans begin to head north, followed by a flock of snowbirds, please remember to enjoy the offerings from this newsletter calendar before departing.

As we speak of departing, we find it necessary to remind everyone that a long and sometimes destructive storm season lies ahead. 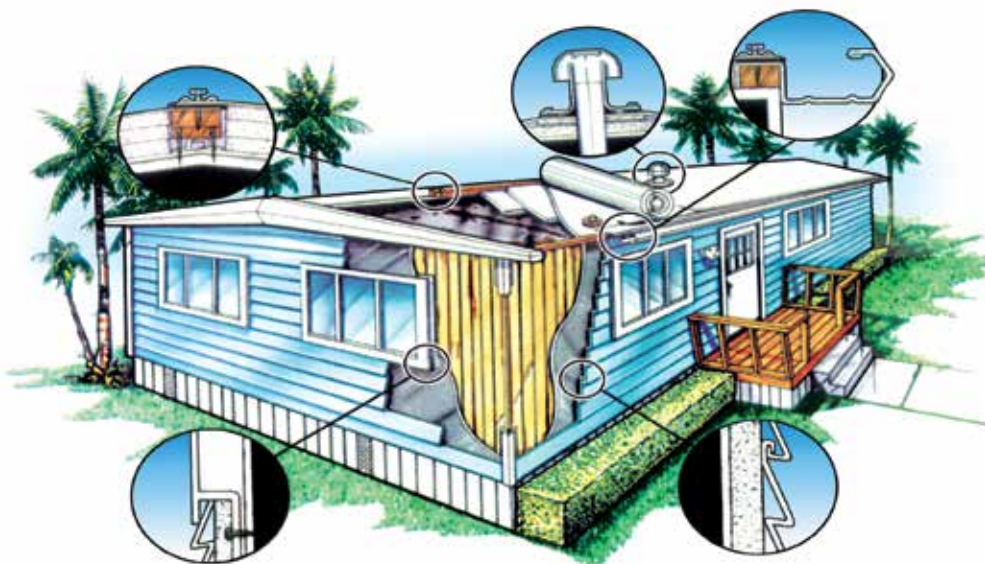
