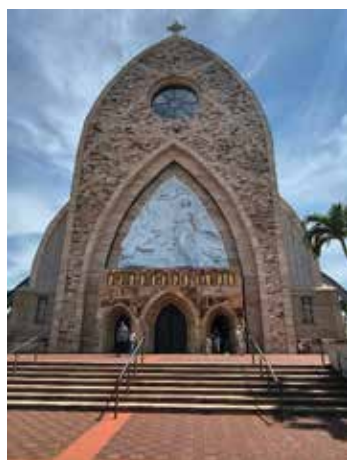

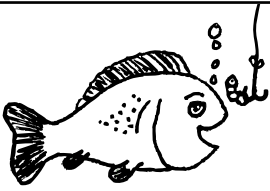

Here's How We Do It

When - Where - Who - How For 6 months, from October through March, the HOA sponsors a Potluck Supper on the 3rd Thursday of the month. Doors open at 5pm and festivities start at 5:30pm.

The tables and chairs in the clubhouse have been set up to accommodate the number of people who have signed up. We often have between 80 and 100 attending.

The main entree is purchased by the HOA and prepared by the volunteer hosts. Everyone who has signed up should bring their own plate, glass, silverware, napkin, and beverage of choice. Each person who attends should bring a side dish or dessert with a quantity to serve at least six servings. Our emcee calls the tables in random order to fix their plates. No second plates allowed until all tables have been called. At the end of the evening, we hope everyone will pitch in to clean up their tables and any debris that has landed on the floor. This is free of charge for HOA members. Nonmembers and guests are \$7 per person. HOA Annual memberships are \$15 per person and expire on March 31.

The HOA Board will volunteer for November Turkey and December Ham. We will be looking for hosts for Jan., Feb., and March. We hope everyone stays healthy and we look forward to the start of group activities

IN MY NECK OF THE WOODS...



In my neck of the woods (Vermont) sugaring season is wrapping up for another year. I understand it was a short but productive season.

The bucket form of gathering Maple sap is only used by very small producers and have to be gathered by hand. Most Sugaring operations involve gathering of the Maple sap via tubing that brings the sap directly to the Sugarhouse.

Did you know:

- It takes 40 gallons of sap to make 1 gallon of maple syrup.
- Hours of boiling are necessary to get the right consistency.
- Sap runs when it is below freezing at night and around 40 degrees during the day.
- Syrup is finished when it is 7 degrees above boiling for approximately 219 degrees.

Sugar on Snow.

- Maple syrup is heated in a sauce pan to around 235 degrees.
- Clean snow (no yellow snow) is gathered and packed in container and the syrup is drizzled over the snow to make a taffy like candy. The candy is then picked off with a fork and eaten. (Heaven on earth to us Vermonters)

This treat is served with donuts and pickles.

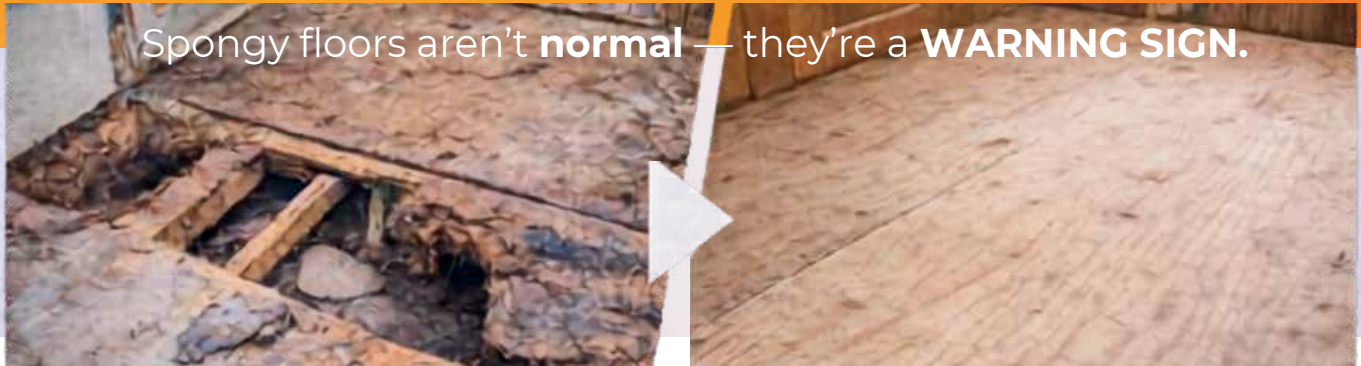

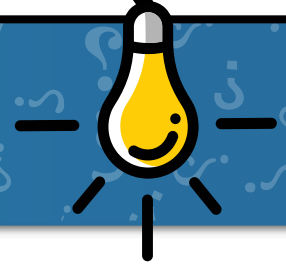
