



COPD STOPLIGHT TOOL

We are all familiar with stoplights. They tell us when to go, slow down, or stop. This model can also teach us when to act with our health. This health sheet is not meant to take the place of your health care team's advice. Use it along with your health care team to find extra steps you can take to manage your health and reach your goals.

GREEN ZONE

Are you in the green zone today?

In the green zone, no extra action is required.

- Your breathing is usual for you.
- You have usual energy and activity levels.
- You have usual amounts of sputum that is clear.
- You are taking medicines and inhalers/nebulizers as prescribed.
- If you have oxygen, you are using as prescribed.
- You are exercising regularly and eating nutritious foods.
- You are avoiding smoke and inhaled irritants.

YELLOW ZONE

Are you in the yellow zone today?

In the yellow zone, you should connect with your health care team today. You have symptoms that need medical attention.

- You have increasing amounts of sputum.
- You see a change in color of sputum (yellow, green, brown).
- You have worsening shortness of breath, different from usual shortness of breath that does not improve after using your inhaler/nebulizer or other methods (pursed lip, deep breathing techniques, rest/relaxation, avoiding triggers/irritants, using a fan).

RED ZONE


Are you in the red zone today?
In the red zone, call 911 or go to the closest emergency room.

- You have severe shortness of breath, even at rest.
- You are not able to do any activity because you can't breathe.
- You have a fever of 100.4 or higher or shaking with chills.
- You are feeling confused or very sleepy.
- You have chest pains or pressure, a fast or irregular heartbeat, or feel dizzy, faint, or weak.
- You are coughing up blood.

With Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), there are things you should do every day.

You should:

- Avoid fumes, pollution, or dust can make your breathing worse.
- Don't use tobacco in any form. Quitting commercial tobacco products is the single most important thing you can do to improve your health and protect your family's health. It's never too late to quit.
- Find ways to move your body can improve your energy levels and strengthen your muscles.
- Gain control of breathing and to breathe more efficiently.
- Choose a variety of fruits and vegetables, whole grains, lean proteins, and low-fat dairy foods. Limit saturated fat and dietary sodium (salt).
- Wash your hands often and stay away from people who are sick.
- Manage anxiety to prevent shortness of breath from worsening.





Community Dumpster Days provide residents with a convenient opportunity to dispose of yard waste to keep our neighborhood beautiful. The Dumpster will be available from 5:00am to 2:00pm on designated days and is located in the gates of our maintenance shop.

Permitted Items: small shrubs, bushes and plants. Leaf and grass trimmings. Bundled sticks no longer than 3.5 feet. Small organic materials.

Items NOT Permitted: home renovation materials, construction debris, electronics, carpet, tile, bricks, windows, doors, furniture, appliances or household garbage.

If you are unsure whether an item is allowed, please contact the management office at before placing it in the dumpster. Residents who are in violation will be subject to penalties.

Scammers Targeting Veterans

Scammers are targeting Veterans and their families by creating fraudulent letters, emails, and texts often including fake VA letterheads and logos, making it difficult to distinguish genuine VA communications from scams.

Fake VA Letterheads and Logos: Scammers often fake VA letterheads, logos, and phone numbers to seem authentic. VA letters include appeal rights.

Claims of Overpayment: Scammers claim you have been overpaid on your VA benefits and now owe money back to VA

Pressure tactics: Scammers may pressure you into making immediate payments directly to them, instead of through official VA payment channels.

Requests for Sensitive Information: Scammers may ask for sensitive information, such as your VA credentials, passwords, or financial information.

Verify overpayments: Verify the authenticity of debt notifications by logging into your official VA.gov account. For more information visit va.gov/manage-va-debt.

Be cautious of unsolicited contact: Be wary of unsolicited emails or texts, demanding personal details or directing you to external websites that are not part of VA.gov.

Do not pay upfront fees: If someone demands an upfront payment to help with your VA debt or claims, it's a scam. VA provides free help with managing debts and claims.

Never Share login information: VA will never ask for your VA login credentials or password.
