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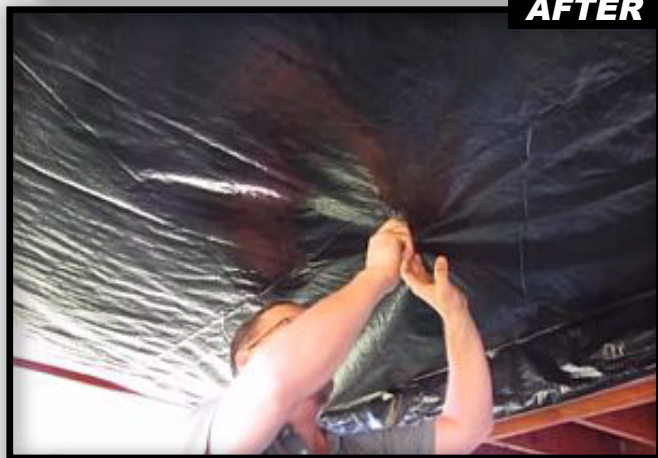
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FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

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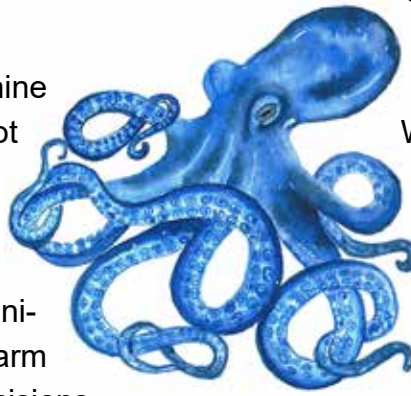
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INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT THE OCTOPUS

The octopus has three hearts, nine brains, and blue blood, and that is not the most interesting things about them.



- Three hearts – two hearts pump blood to the gills, while the third pumps blood to the rest of the body. When an octopus swims, the third heart temporarily stops beating. This is why octopuses prefer crawling to swimming. Swimming terrifies them literally to the point of cardiac arrest.

- An octopus has one central brain and eight addition mini-brains, one in each arm. Each arm can taste, touch, and make decisions independently. When an octopus reaches into a crevice, the arm figures out what to do without consulting the head.
- Their arms can taste. Thousands of suckers contain chemical receptors that let an octopus taste and smell what it touches. They can regrow lost arms. If a predator grabs an arm, an octopus can shed it and later grow a new one.
- They are surprisingly strong. Their hundreds of suckers can grip objects with impressive force while remaining delicate enough to handle fragile items.
- They have excellent eyesight. Their eyes are highly developed and can detect polarized light, helping them navigate and hunt underwater.
- Mothers are devoted parents. A female may guard and clean her eggs continuously for months without eating. After the eggs hatch, she usually dies shortly afterward.
- They shoot ink to escape predators. The ink creates a dark cloud that confuses attackers and may even interfere with a predator's sense of smell.
- Its blood is blue because it uses copper-based hemocyanin to carry oxygen instead of iron-based hemoglobin. This makes it more efficient at low temperatures and low oxygen environments. Evolution produced a completely different solution to the same problem mammals solved differently.

- It can change the color, texture, and pattern of its skin in 200 milliseconds. Not just for camouflage. For communication. For mood expression. An octopus has been observed dreaming, its skin cycling rapidly through colors, apparently reliving its day.
- Octopuses have been observed collecting coconut shells from the ocean floor to carry as portable shelters. This requires planning for a future need. It requires the animal to carry something useless now for a benefit that will arrive later. That is abstract thought.
- They can squeeze through tiny openings. Since they have no bones, they can fit through almost any hole that's larger than their beak – the only hard part of their body.
- An octopus lives only one to two years. In that time, it learns, adapts, plans, and dreams. The question of whether it experiences something worth calling a life is no longer considered a philosophical curiosity. It is a biological one.
- The octopus evolved its intelligence completely independently from vertebrate intelligence. It represents a second solution to the problem of how to be smart. It teaches us that consciousness is not one thing. It is at least two. Probably more.
- No two octopus species are exactly alike. Scientists have identified more than 300 species, ranging from tiny species smaller than an inch long to the enormous Giant Pacific octopus, which can have an arm span of over 15 feet.
