

Bahia Vista Residents,

By now most of all the holidays are behind us. I would like to wish everyone a Very Happy New Year. I hope this year is a healthy and great year for all of us.

I would like to announce our annual meeting will be Saturday March 21st at 9:30 AM at the Clubhouse. Our annual letter will be going out around the 1st of the year. At this time I would like to say our annual dues for the HOA will increase from \$20 a year to \$25 a year. We have not had an increase in dues since 2021. There are several factors that went into this decision. Like everything else, prices have increased.

Just to name a few of the boards increases are as follows:

- Postage 78 cents per letter, increase cost of our liability insurance,
- Cost of printing just to name some of our increases.

With this increase we will maintain our present costs? (On behalf of the board thank you for understanding.)

Why one should join the HOA:

1. The HOA Hosts Community Events. We as a group host four events a year in conjunction with Sun Management partnership.
2. HOA is your voice with Sun Management. We suggest improvements and new ideas to Sun. We meet regularly with Sun Management, and quarterly with our Regional Vice President.
3. The HOA provides a monthly news letter which is delivered to everyone's home. We provide the residents with a yearly directory.
4. These are just some areas we are involved in.
5. As always everyone on the HOA board is a volunteer.

Just a reminder in order to vote on any issue one has to be in good standing with their dues. If anyone is interested in being a member of the HOA board nominations will be excepted from the floor at the annual meeting.

Our new by laws states per Article 12 Section 2 - Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting for a term of one year. At the end of the 1 year term the directors shall be subject to re-election.

I would like to thank Sun Management for their donation to the annual trolley ride. I would like to thank BVE Community Activities for providing the Christmas Pot Luck and also thank everyone who helped out.

We are planning a Town Hall Meeting sometime in the month of January with our Regional Vice President Lejia Bosnjake. Our next HOA meeting will be January 6th. Hope to see you all at our annual meeting on March 21st.

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

Track Phillipi dredging on website

Sarasota County government has created a web page to provide residents updated information on the Phillipi Creek dredging project. The page includes video updates, answers to frequently asked questions and a map of the project area. The page is at SCGov.net/PhillipiCreek.

Through this page, the public may also find links to the water atlas, a fact sheet and two maps, one of the dredging areas east and west of U.S. 41.

All permits have been received by the West Coast Inland Navigation District, which is managing the current project portion from the mouth of Phillipi Creek to Tuttle Avenue to ensure a 30-foot-wide, 4-foot-deep mean low water area along the center line.

Once dredging contracts have been awarded an estimated operational time line will be developed. A minimum 10-foot buffer will be maintained from docks and other structures, meaning in some areas where the creek narrows the intended width may not be achievable.

Phillipi Creek is a 7.2-mile stream located in the Little Sarasota Bay Watershed, flowing from the Celery Fields east of I-75 to Roberts Bay. The county's stormwater infrastructure drains into the creek and ultimately into Little Sarasota Bay.
