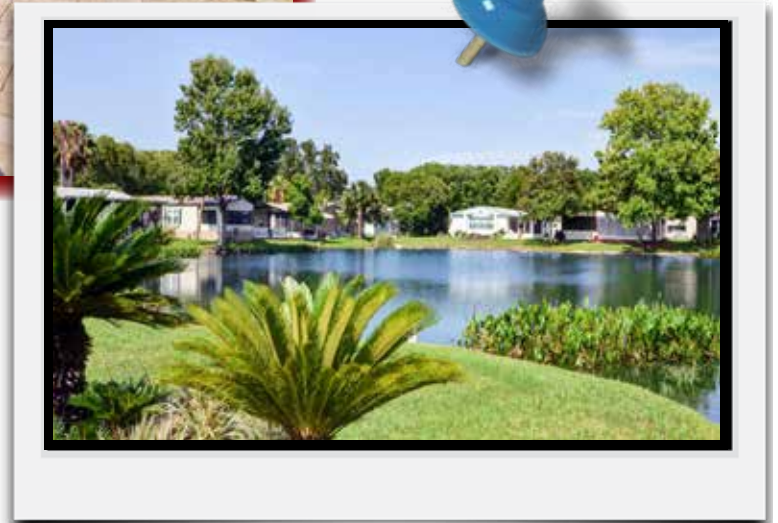

TRIVIA CORNER

The History Behind April Fool's Day

April Fool's is a long-standing tradition where people play harmless pranks or practical jokes on each other. Its exact origin isn't certain, but historians have a few widely accepted theories.

1. The Calendar Change Theory (Most Popular) – In 1582, Pope Gregory XIII introduced the Gregorian calendar. Before that, many Europeans celebrated the New Year around late March through April 1. When the new calendar moved New Year's Day to January 1, some people either didn't hear about the change or refused to adopt it. People who continued celebrating in early April were mocked and called "April fools." Pranks were played on them, such as sending them on fake errands or sticking paper fish on their backs in France (called Poisson d'Avril).
2. Earlier Spring Festivals – Some historians think the tradition is even older and tied to Spring festivals that celebrated trickery and role reversals, such as:
 - a. Hilaria in ancient Rome, where people wore disguises and mocked each other.
 - b. Holi in India, which involves playful mischief and throwing colored powder.
3. First Written Mentions - One of the earliest references to April fooling appears in a 1561 Flemish poem, which described a nobleman sending a servant on ridiculous errands on April 1.
4. Modern April Fool's Pranks – By the 1700's, the tradition was well established in Britain and France. In modern times, newspapers, TV stations and companies often joined in with elaborate fake announcements. Famous examples include:
 - a. The BBC "spaghetti tree" TV hoax in 1957.
 - b. Tech companies announcing fake products.
 - c. Taco Bell buys the Liberty Bell (1996)
 - d. Google's "Gmail Motion" (2011)
 - e. The Left Handed Whopper (1998)

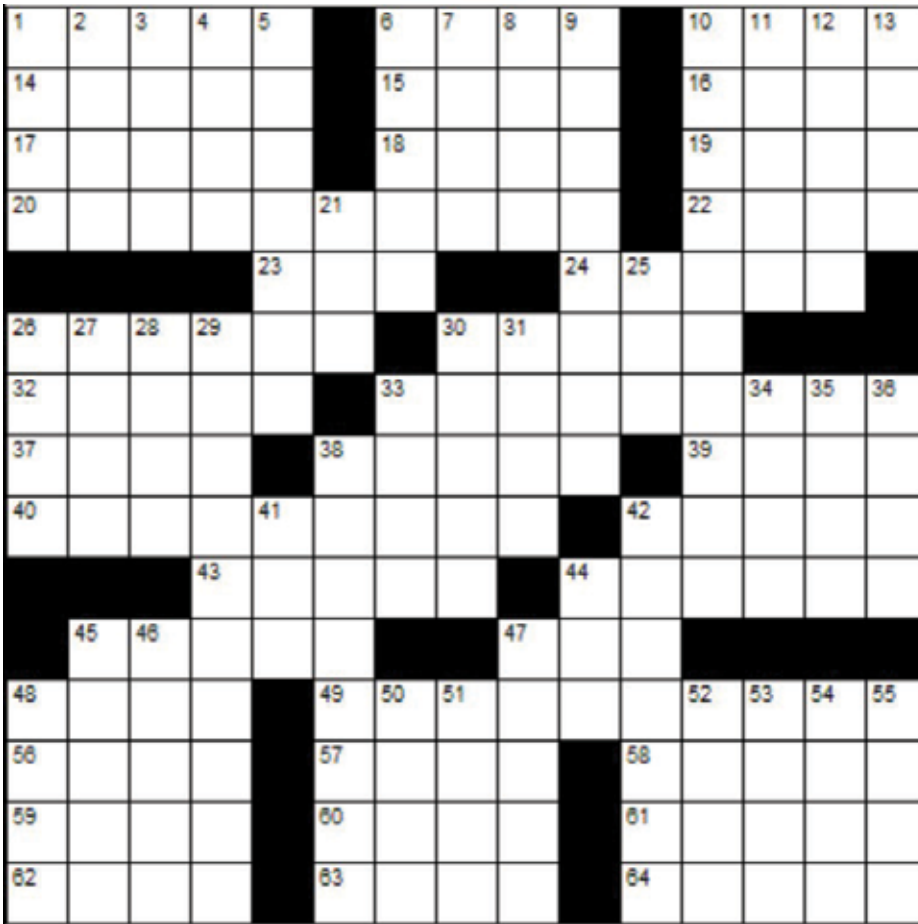

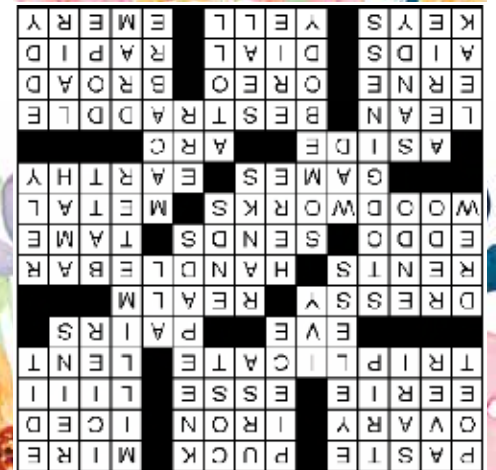
