Phishing Scams: Emails, texts, calls or messages tricking you into giving personal information.

How to spot it:

- Unsolicited emails or texts with urgent messages: “Your account is locked!”, “Your grandson is in jail!”
- Bad grammar and generic greetings “Dear Customer”
- Suspicious links

How to protect yourself:

- **Never - Never** click links in unexpected emails.
- Avoid entering personal information on sites you don’t recognize.
- Enable multi-factor authentication (site will send a text or call the number it has on file for you for verification) on all important accounts.
- Install strong antivirus software on all your devices to block malicious links and prevent malware from stealing your private information.
