#### WASTE NOT WANT NOT

Starting October 9, 2025 for The Gardens, garbage, yard waste, and recycling will all be collected once per week all on the same day. Each material type will be picked up separately, but all collections will occur on Thursday.

#### What to Expect:

- One collection day per week (Thursday),
- Three separate pickups: one each for garbage, recycling, and yard waste,
- Place all items curbside by 6:00am on Thursday, following the separation guidelines.

Weekly garbage pickup is limited to the contents of your bin. If you have extra items that won't fit, you can schedule a special pickup in advance for a fee by calling 311 or submitting a request online to the 311 Division. Alternatively, you can take the excess waste directly to the landfill.

Place bins 3 feet from the curb and keep it/them at least 3 feet from cars, mailboxes, meters/backflow assemblies, yard waste, and any other obstruction.

Starting October 1, 2025, plastic bags will no longer be accepted for yard waste. Yard waste must be in bins, bundles, or paper lawn and leaf bags. Yard waste will not be collected if it is not properly packaged.

Bulk items are collected per item for an additional fee. Call 941-792-8811 to schedule a pickup or request another bin or if you have any questions.

#### WALKING WHILE DARK

There are a few of us that walk, bike, walk our dog or drive after dark or before sunrise in the morning. PLEASE – PLEASE wear light colored clothes and/ or reflective clothes and some type of light so you can be seen. I hear often from people that they almost hit someone because he/she was walking or bike riding and wearing dark clothes.

TGHOA offers reflective vests, a great investment. You can buy lights that you can wear. At a minimum you need a good flashlight that is turned on, not turned off in your pocket. It is better to be safe then a statistic. You can even get a lighted collar for your best friend. It is getting dark sooner at night and staying dark longer in the morning PLEASE make sure you can be seen in the dark.

#### NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH NEEDS YOU

We are in need of additional people to help with neighborhood watch. It involves riding around the park once a month for an hour, or a little longer depending on your speed, using a golf cart provided by The Gardens. We are a non-confrontational group where your cell phone is your most important asset. While we suggest doing it as a group of two people, a single person can do it. There are a few more things to know but it isn't complicated.

Email or text (607-644-3176) are the best ways to contact me, my phone is often set on do not disturb mode so calls happen that I don't know about until after they happened. If you call and it goes straight to voice mail please leave a message.

#### PHANTOM HACKER SCAM

A cybersecurity expert, Pete Nicoletti, chief information security officer at Check Point, warns that a scam has been used to drain entire life savings or retirement accounts and has become devastating for seniors.

FBI Los Angeles on July 15 posted a reminder on X about the Phantom Hacker Scam, which has cost

Americans over \$1 billion since 2024. The FBI said the scam targets senior citizens and warns that victims could lose their life savings.

The scam operates in three phases: a "tech support impostor," "financial institution impostor" and a "US government impostor."

In the first phase, a tech support impostor will contact victims through text, phone call or email, then direct them to download a program allowing the scammer remote access to their computer. Then, the scammer asks victims to open their financial accounts to determine whether there have been any unauthorized charges, which the FBI says is most lucrative for targeting. Afterwards, the scammer will choose an account to target, then tell the victim they will get a call for further instructions from the fraud department of their bank.

In the second phase, the financial institution impostor will then call the victim and inform them that their funds have been accessed by a hacker and must be moved to a safe third party account. Victims are then instructed to send the money via wire transfer, cash or cryptocurrency, and are told to send multiple transactions over a span of days or months.

In the third phase of the scam, the victim could be contacted by someone posing as a U.S. government employee, who prompts the individual to move their funds to an alias account.

Many seniors are posting things on Facebook like "they're a Corvette collector". The criminals are using artificial intelligence to look for those types of characteristics and profiles. They'll send you an email or a message saying, "hey, that Corvette that you ordered a month ago is now available and for \$500 you can get it and we'll deliver it to you right away. And of course, the senior thinks, 'well, I'm a Corvette collector and maybe I was forgetful and ordered that Corvette."

If victims report their funds stolen the same day, there's a chance. It's 10, 15%. If it is delayed beyond that, it's not good. It's gone.




