














Tree Maintenance & Yard Debris

Homeowners are responsible for trimming trees on their own lots and for properly disposing of any debris. Do not place branches or trimmings by the roadside.

If branches fall into your yard from a neighboring property, it is still the homeowner's responsibility to remove and dispose of them.

For trash pickup, all branches must be:

- · Cut into 3-foot sections
- · Tied into bundles
- Fully placed inside your trash can

Thank you for helping keep our neighborhood clean and safe!

Fire Safety Reminder

Bonfires and fire pits are not permitted—this includes temporary fire pits placed anywhere on the property, including in front of the office.

Clubhouse & Events Etiquette

Please respect all scheduled clubhouse events. Bowling game must not be played within **30 minutes of any pre-planned event** to avoid disruption.

Also, please remember to clean the clubhouse after each event to help keep it welcoming for everyone.

Do not rinse food, paint, or any other materials down the bathroom drains—these systems are not designed to handle such waste. Thank you for helping maintain our shared spaces!

Demo Work & Street Safety

Please use caution when driving or walking in active construction areas.

For your safety, please avoid streets where demolition

or construction is in progress—unless you live on that street. Unnecessary traffic can slow down work and increase the risk of accidents.

It is not the easiest thing to go out during the summer months to deliver the newsletters, and thankfully, there is cooler weather on the horizion. Remember, your block captains are volunteers. They kindly take the time out of their lives to check in on you, deliver your newsletter, collect information on the member/resident sheets and collect HOA dues.

HOA MEMBERSHIP

We started collecting dues for 2025 in December of 2024 and will continue through out the year. Remember, your membership starts January 1st and runs through December 31st no matter what month you join. If you intend on voting in December, you must have a current membership by November 1st.

Everyone asks, what do I get when I join the HOA? Well, you get a board of 7 people who are working together, and who will stand up for you against management. This same board keeps management on their toes by making sure they are complying with any and all city codes and ordinances. For ONLY \$20 a year, you join with your community to support the board and all it's efforts to offer activities for everyone, EVEN THE FREE ONES. \$2 of that fee goes straight into the legal fund. Your membership also gives you a vote and voice at members meetings. If you rent a unit in this community and join the HOA, you are considered an Associate Member, and entitled to all the same benefits as members but with no voting rights and also may not run for the Board.

Remember that there is strength in numbers. If you have not yet joined, your block captain will be happy to come over and collect from you. Or, contact me and I will make it happen.



Your HOA has a fiduciary responsibility to its

membership. Definition of fiduciary: one who obligates himself or herself to act on behalf of another (as in managing money or property) and assumes a duty to act in good faith and with care, candor, and loyalty in fulfilling the obligation.







The Harbor View Mobile Manor office offers an automated voice calling system. This system allows the office to quickly inform all residents of important community related business. Calls you may receive from the office include water shut offs, precautionary and boil water notices, hurricane and weather updates, lost pets or to simply inform you of an upcoming event. VOTING CERTIFICATE

In any regular, annual or special membership meeting, the owners of a mobile home located on a lot in the park (unit) shall be entitled to cast one (1) vote for each unit. When a unit is owned by one (1) person his or her right to vote shall be established by the record title of his unit. If a unit is owned by more than one (1) person or is under lease, the person entitled to cast the vote for the unit shall be designated by a Certificate signed by all of the Record Owners if the unit and filed with the Secretary of the Association. In the event a unit is owned by a corporation the person entitled to cast the vote shall be designated by Certificate signed by the Officers of the corporation with the formalities required of a deed requiring 2 witnesses and a notary, and filed with the Secretary of the Association. Such Certificate shall be valid until it is revoked or superseded by a subsequent Certificate or until the ownership or the unit is changed or recorded. For purposes of this paragraph a purchaser under Contract for Sale, shall not be regarded as an owner. The proper filing of a Certificate designating the person entitled to cast the vote of a unit is a condition precedent to that person's vote. In the event such a Certificate is not on file, the vote of such owner shall not be considered.

If you filled one out before, you do not need to fill out another one. If your voter designation has changed, you will need to submit a new form.
