Bahia Vista Residents,

On behalf of the board we would like to welcome the snow birds who have arrived early from their honeymoon away from home. We hope many of you along with the residents of the park attend the events that are planned. We also welcome new residents and snow birds to our October HOA meeting at 6:30 at the clubhouse.

Just a few updates:

- 1. The board will be meeting with our new Regional Vice President Lejla Bosnjak, September 18th for a round table discussion. Updates from that meeting will be on the October agenda.
- 2. By now everyone should have received your letter for our new rental and pass through charges for the year of 2026.
- 3. Update on Palm Street Lights Still waiting on Sun to sign the contract for the underground wiring. (I hope by the time every one reads the October Green Sheet everything will be up and running.) If not started, the board plans on going to senior management.
- 4. Homes to be demolished there are only two homes that still need to be removed. One should be removed by this reading. The other is the gopher turtle house. The gopher turtle is under the Endangered Species Act so Sun is currently working with the state of Florida on a time frame to remove the house.
- 5. Hurricane Damage Homes 20 homes still have outstanding contracts. 6 homes owners have lost their deposits from dishonest contractors.
- 6. New mobile homes we are already seen the preparation of the lots for the new homes which are on the way and should be delivered soon.
- 7. Saturday Coffee should be starting back up in October.
- 8. Christmas Trolley Ride. Take a trolley ride to view the neighborhood Christmas lights. This is always a popular event. We're in the process of getting all the information, date and time to be determined. Last year we had 2 full trolleys.

The HOA Board hopes to see you all at our next meeting on October 7th.






