■ 4 Sided Inspection

Bill will begin the annual 4 sided inspection. If we see it, we report it. Please be mindful of him on and around the property.

- ⇒ No Signs in windows or on homes, except 1 For Sale Sign in Window.
- ⇒ Curb Appeal—weeds, edging, shrubs, trees
- ⇒ Doors/Windows—in good repair, no torn screen broken windows
- ⇒ Siding Clean and/or Fresh Paint
- ⇒ Gutters free of debris
- ⇒ Roof free of debris—no tarps
- ⇒ No Outside Storage
- ⇒ Flags—2 standard size and 2 small garden flags only
- ⇒ Tree Stumps removed and/or grinded down to ground level

■ Safety Tip

This is a good time to check your smoke detectors/fire extinguishers.

■ Daylight Saving Time

Don't forget to set your clocks back one hour on Sunday, November 2nd!

Attention Ariana Village Residents, Your CAP Patrol Needs Your Help

The CAP program is in desperate need of new members to patrol our neighborhood, in order to assist our residents and keeping our community safe. There are morning, afternoon, evening and night-time positions available. Requirements are, that you must be a licensed driver, agree to a background check (which may take up to 60 days to be returned) and commit to a one day, Sheriff's Office training program, somewhere in Polk County. Upon completing the one day training program, you will be paired up with an experienced CAP member for a shift or two, until you are comfortable with patrolling on your own or with a partner and at that point, you can select your time slot from a list of available dates and times. All it takes, once a CAP member, is to commit to at least 2 hours per week, which can be split into two, one hour tours. Being a CAP member and patrolling the community, is also an excellent way to get around the neighborhood and meet new people or just simply greet your friends and neighbors along the way. VETERAN'S CORNER

VETERANS INPUT FOR OCT 2025

There Are Three Special Days in October:

- 12 October Fly the flag Columbus Day (Observed)
- 13 October Fly the Flag, United States Navy Birthday (1775)
- 31 October Halloween

Veterans Pay and Disability Issues:

- (1)- The latest projection on VA disability increase for 2026 is projected to be around 2.5% to 2.7%, though analysts have also provided estimate of around 2.4%. The official rate will be determined in mid-October 2025, after the Social "Security Administration" reviews inflation data of the third quarter of 2025. Projected to take effect on Dec 1, 2025 and reflected in the Jan 1, 2026 check.
- (2)- Can a veteran receive both VA disability and Social Security? Yes, a vet can receive both VA disability and social security disability (SSID) benefits simultaneously because the programs are separate and have different eligibility criteria.
- (3)- No specific conditions automatically qualify you for VA disability, instead the VA uses the presumptive rule for certain chronic conditions and conditions related to specific exposures like Agent Orange or service in certain locations that are assumed to be service connected. To be eligible a condition must be service-connected meaning it was incurred or aggravated during service, or be a presumptive condition that manifested within a specific timeframe after service. Common presumptive conditions include certain cancers, heart disease, type 2 diabetes and PTSD.

Our next meeting on 11 Oct will be in conjunction with "Breakfast with Carol". I hope we have good attendance because we have an issue to discuss and then make a decision. The issue is when and where do we want the November meeting. Carol's Breakfast will end in Oct. A couple of options have been identified (1) stay at Ariana clubhouse, leave the meeting day on the 2nd Saturday of the month at 0900 and have coffee with doughnuts/muffins. (2) Pick a restaurant and order off the menu. Hope you can attend.


