


# In Need for Newsletters Delivery Volunteers

## **CHANGING THE PET RULES**

Patti DeLano

I have received several emails from residents about our pet rules. Is it time to make a change?



- 1. It is time for change, and shareholders can decide this by voting on the pet rules at the 2026 meeting. It takes a simple majority vote to allow ownership of dogs anywhere in CCE.
- 2. CCE has fewer than 50 registered dogs, mostly in the pet section, with others allowed under the Americans Disability Act. As more dogs are listed as Emotional Support Animals, liability increases as the Board becomes open to legal errors in processing assistance requests.
- 3. We are a desirable community. Attraction for pet owners or current owners aging in place who want the companionship of a dog but are reluctant to apply for Assistance Animal should not be an issue in our community.

  SEPARATE OR ADDITIONAL ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED
- 4. The way the rule stands now, we cannot bring a trained Therapy Dog, certified by Therapy Dogs International, into CCE to visit residents with medical conditions who request

- it from that organization. Therapy Dogs go to hospitals, schools, nursing homes and courtrooms but cannot visit the sick in CCE outside the pet section. This is a small but important change.
- 5. Dog owners should be allowed to walk their dogs at night in the safety of the park and not be required to take their dogs outside on the walkway where a fall is more dangerous.





#### It's the Law

In Venice, Florida, you are legally required to remove your dog's feces from any public property or private property not belonging to you. Sarasota County, which includes Venice, imposes fines for violations. Venice and Sarasota County Ordinances:

- Cleanup is mandatory: A person with custody of a dog must immediately remove its feces from public and non-owned private property.
- Sanitary disposal: The feces must be disposed of in a sanitary manner.
- Fines for violations: Failure to comply is a civil infraction punishable by fines. The Sarasota County Sheriff's Office lists fees for ordinance violations:

First offense: \$40.00.
Second offense: \$70.00.
Third offense: \$100.00.

• Enforcement: The Venice Code of Ordinances cross-references the removal of animal waste under its solid waste regulations. Florida state law -In general, Florida leaves specific pet waste regulations up to local municipalities, such as Venice.

# What is happening with the old hospital?

Key details about the old ShorePoint Venice Hospital site:

New Owner: The property was sold in 2023 to Hospital Parking Company LLC. Potential Uses: The new owner is exploring options, but a future healthcare use is a possibility. Land Use: The property is zoned for office, professional, and institutional uses. Building Condition: The building itself is reported to be in good condition. Timeline: No reopening timeline has been set, but the new owners are diligently working to make a decision. What is NOT happening at the old ShorePoint Venice Hospital: It is not reopening as part of AdventHealth, as AdventHealth acquired the ShorePoint Health Port Charlotte and Punta Gorda facilities in 2025, not the Venice facility. It has been used for training and critical incident exercises by city and county first responders, which is an invaluable asset to them.






