TGHOA AND YOU

CLUBHOUSE RENOVATIONS: As snowbirds return to The Gardens, they will be greeted by significant updates, especially the renovations to the clubhouse. While there have been some concerns regarding these changes, it is important to note that the improvements have been completed to a high standard. Individual preferences may vary, but the goal was to enhance the facility for everyone. Christina dedicated considerable effort to coordinating the renovation project, ensuring that all details were managed efficiently. One issue that remains under discussion is the size of the tables in the game room/library. This concern is currently being addressed with Murex, following an initial misunderstanding about how the library would be used.

STREET AND RECREATION AREA IMPROVEMENTS: Several streets within The Gardens have undergone repaving, providing smoother surfaces for residents. Plans for additional resurfacing projects are in place for next year, as reflected in the upcoming budget. In addition, both the pickle ball and tennis courts have been refurbished, offering improved recreational facilities.

POND RESTORATION: The ponds remain a significant challenge due to overgrowth. Extensive restoration work has happened, spearheaded by Christina, who facilitated a transition to a highly recommended pond maintenance company. Research revealed that algae removal with a skimmer would be costly and offered no guarantee of success. Contributing factors to the overgrowth include flooding from past hurricanes, insufficient rainfall, and fountain malfunctions. Despite these difficulties, gradual improvement in the pond areas is now evident. The new company will be out twice a month to check the ponds.

FOUNTAIN: The fountain has been out of service for a while. Replacing the fountain was found to be prohibitively expensive, suitable replacement parts were sourced and repairs have been complete. The repairs are expected to help mitigate some ongoing issues.

TGHOA MEMBERSHIP AND MEETINGS: The first TGHOA general meeting is scheduled for November

LAMP POSTS

The executive committee of Neighborhood Watch is putting pink ribbons on the lamp posts that aren't lit when they go by. If you find a pink ribbon on your lamp post, please check the light bulb and replace if that is the issue. If not, it would appear to be an electrical issue. If this is the case you can sign up on the bulletin board in the information room for help. Please remember that YOU are responsible for your lamp post and its operation. We continue to see more than 10% of lamp posts (over 60) that are dark.

PROTECT YOURSELF

According to the AARP, seniors in America lose over \$28 billion every year to fraud, and shockingly, 70% of it comes from people they know: family members, neighbors, caregivers, and "friends."

Step 1 Understand how family, neighbor, "friend" fraud puts you at risk:

The most common cases involve:

- Reconnection: Estranged relatives suddenly reconnecting with hidden motives in tow,
- Identity theft: Family members using your loved one's name, Social Security number, or credit cards,
- Friend-stalking: Casual acquaintances digging for personal info to exploit.

If your family has tension, estranged members, or unresolved drama, you could be prime targets. Recognizing this risk is the first essential step to prevention.

Step 2 Protect yourself by locking down your personal data:

Armed with a few details, scammers can impersonate a relative, hack an account, or manipulate you over the phone. Think about how easy it is for an estranged family member to get updates about your life and financial status. Limit how much you share online or delete such information to prevent it from appearing on people search sites. Ultimately, controlling what's available online is one of the most effective ways to protect yourself from identity theft, fraud, and unwanted contact.

Step 3 Unlist your phone number to block scammers: One of the easiest ways for scammers to reach and manipulate seniors is through phone calls. A friendly voice claiming to be a long-lost cousin, or someone pretending to be a financial adviser, goes a long way. If your landline or cell number is publicly listed, it's a ticking time bomb.

You can:

- Contact their phone provider and request that the number be unlisted.
- Remove their number from online directories,
- Consider getting a new number and keeping it private.

The fewer ways fraudsters can reach you the better.

In conclusion, family fraud is one of those ugly, uncomfortable topics we tend to avoid. But the regret of not acting is far worse. Start today and remove your personal data from the web. Remember to unlist your phone number and lock down your sensitive information. Every measure helps you maintain control over your finances.

LAWS IN FLORIDA FOR OPERATING A GOLF CART

As of July 2023, drivers must be at least 15 with a learner's permit or 16 with a driver's license to operate a golf cart in Florida. Golf carts are generally restricted to daytime operation unless equipped with proper lighting and local ordinances permit nighttime use. Golf carts cannot be driven on or used to cross a public road unless specifically indicated.

While it is adorable to have your younger grandchildren drive your golf cart it is dangerous for them, you and possibly other people on the roads and/or walking in The Gardens. While it might be cute, please don't drive a golf cart with a young child on your lap. You wouldn't do that in your car so please don't do that in your golf cart.


