





#### **Storage Compound News**

As always, your compound committee staff looks forward to everybody's return. The volunteers on the compound committee look forward to serve the community, after all we are all neighbors and that is what makes Harbor Cove that special place to live.

For those new to the community our storage compound is managed by a group of volunteers. There is a direct phone line (941-234-9062) that is answered by the "duty officer". If you need storage for your boat or RV you only need to call that number. It is published every month in the Bulletin and also appears on the sign just inside the storage compound gate. It will be a pleasure to serve you.

For those storage compound users that are returning if you are not quite sure what space you had last year please double check your assignment with a compound committee member. There are lots of empty spaces this time of year but most are assigned so be sure you are parked in the correct space.

As a reminder all boats, cars and RVs require current registration to be parked in the storage compound. Please affix your current state/provincial registration stickers if you have not yet done so. If you get new equipment, please let us know so we can affix a new Harbor Cove permit sticker.

We will continue our moratorium adopted in 2018 not accepting permanently parked storage trailers. We simply will run out of room for boats and after all we are a boating community. Locally there are plenty of commercial storage facilities available for storage of home goods. On occasion residents may have a need to park storage trailers temporarily or may have visitors that have campers, cars, trucks, or motorhomes that should not be parked in front of your house, call us, we can usually accommodate those requests on a temporary basis, generally not exceeding 10 days.

When I arrived early October and took my initial review of our storage area I noticed a couple of house keeping issues, such as missing space numbers which we will get to before high season. I did notice a few boat trailers out of line or not in

their assigned space. Get those fixed folks, your neighbors will arrive and not be able to get into their own parking space.

To prevent damage to your own or your neighbor's equipment please use a spotter backing up if you need one when maneuvering. If you need help call the compound direct cell number and we can help if needed. 941-234-9062

#### **AMC BRIEFS**

The Association of Myakka Communities (AMC) is comprised of Lazy River, River Walk, Harbor Isles, Harbor Cove and LaCasa. Representatives from each of these mobile home parks meet on a monthly basis. Each park has 2-4 volunteer residents attending the meetings.

The following is a summary of the topics discussed at the October 15 2025 meeting.

County condemnation of properties continues to be an issue. Sarasota county is not forgiving or helpful when it is obvious a home can not be lived in. Owners of homes are walking away leaving the situation to the community to resolve. Legal fees, loss of income, puts a burden on park budgets; discussion ended with agreement this is a situation which will be with us for an extended time. Annual Meeting of AMC is February 18, 2026, 10:30 am at LaCasa. This is an open meeting to the public, there will be speakers, more information will be available as event date gets closer.

An overview of the sidewalk (co-use golf cart) and entrance/exit for the 5 communities was presented. Summary is (1) not legal for golf cart use on the sidewalk between the 5 parks and Save-a-Lot. (2) studies for pedestrian, bike traffic volume is next. (3) Six months has to pass before anymore work will occur for temporary changes to exit our parks.

Other topics covered included:

Possible retirement options offered to future CAM's Home sales starting to happen; open houses planned; having a cooperative agreement between community and real estate company.

SRQ's are helping to fill empty/damaged homes. Out of compliance homes will be strongly addressed by sending warning letters, fining, unannounced visits, eviction notices.

Responsibilities of owner/caretaker during summer pertaining to outside appearance of home. Neighbor to neighbor help activity if a person living in the home can not do the work.

Next Meeting November 19, 9:30 am at Harbor Isles.


