

He was very healthy and very active for a long, long time. He loved to get drinks out of the sink or the bathtub. His favorite thing was to annoy Mom until she turned on the faucet to let him have water out of the faucet. We loved each other and loved to cuddle and sleep together. We gave each other baths and at times we liked to pick on each other just to hear the other one shout "Hey cut it out!" In the summer we live in Maine. We love it in Maine too. We enjoyed our life on a boat where we could watch the sea life and water. We had many friends, both human

and animal. We really liked watching the birds! We just love being where it's 72 and sunny all the time. We travel back-and-forth. Ringo loved to travel and loved to sit in laps and look out the window. I like to hide in the corner and cry. My brother recently went over the rainbow bridge. Ringo was the ultimate big brother—full of personality and affection. It is so quiet without him, but I bet he's still watching over me, probably trying to drink from some celestial faucet up there beyond the rainbow bridge. My Mom and I miss him very, very much. We are getting used to it though. My Mom is going to make him an urn in the pottery studio.

My Mom keeps reminding me that You can't start the next chapter of your life if you keep re-reading the last one." This is a quote from one of the books she reads. We love it here at CCE and hope to stay a very long time. If you're walking past the house, feel free to shout out and say "hello Crybaby." I will probably be chasing a lizard or sleeping in the sun. I want to thank all the people who have provided pet care to me and my brother when my mom travels. You guys are the best!! Not every kitty gets that kind of love and devotion but as a cat, I must say, I feel I have definitely earned it with my big heart (and big voice!). You're a legend Ringo! You will always be in our hearts. So, watch over us as we soak up more sunshine and live new exciting chapters! Mom and I will be sending purrs and scratches from near and afar. Love, Crybaby.



The Breakfast Company -Coming Spring 2026

After opening locations in Bradenton, Sarasota's The Landings and Rosemary District, and University Town Center, The Breakfast Company will expand to Venice at 2996 Executive Drive, planning to open in spring 2026, according to a press release. It will be the locally owned business's fifth restaurant (it also has a commissary location), as well as its first in south Sarasota County and first with a drive thru.

Dimitri Syros and his mother Terri Syros-King opened the original The Breakfast Company in Bradenton in 2020. As its name suggests, The Breakfast Company serves a variety of breakfast and lunch favorites, with flavors of Greek and Mediterranean cuisine found throughout the menu, such as a Mediterranean skillet bowl with gyro meat, feta and tzatziki, or an avgolemono chicken lemon rice soup.




