

#### **COOKING CORNER**

Merry Christmas Spanish Lakes!

Once again, the holidays are upon us, along with all the parties and social get togethers. This month I am featuring 3 delicious appetizers and a few suggestions for those last-minute quick snacks.

Keep crackers, cheese and smoked meats on hand during the holidays for when family and friends pop in.

#### \*Quick Tip! \*

Pour a warm jar of jam or jelly over a block of cream cheese and serve with crackers. Super Yummy!

#### **ZUCCHINI PIZZA APPETIZERS**

This is one of my favorite recipes. It can also be served as a side dish.

#### **Ingredients:**

1 Zucchini (8 or 9 inch) cut into half inch coins

1 jar of Pizza Sauce (any brand)

1 cup of Mozzarella cheese

Italian Seasoning

Garlic powder

Mini slices of pepperoni

#### **Instructions**

- 1. Place the zucchini coins in a glass or ceramic baking dish. Microwave for 3 minutes.
- 2. Remove from oven and spoon pizza sauce on each, sprinkle with Italian seasonings and garlic powder, and microwave for one minute.
- 3. Remove from microwave and top with cheese and pepperoni. Microwave for one more minute.
- 4. Cool, serve and enjoy.

#### BAKED CRABMEAT DIP

#### **Ingredients:**

2 pkgs. of cream cheese (8 oz)

8 oz fresh Crabmeat

3 Tbsp finely chopped onion

2 Tbsp milk

1 Tbsp horseradish

Dash of pepper

1/2 cup toasted sliced almonds

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 375F
- 2. Combine all ingredients except almonds, mix well. Spoon into buttered small baking dish. Sprinkle with almonds.
- 3. Bake for 15 minutes. Serve with a heavy cracker.

#### HOT ARTICHOKE DIP

#### **Ingredients:**

1 12 oz jar of marinated artichokes drained and chopped

1 cup of low-fat mayonnaise

1 cup of shredded Parmesan Cheese

1 cup of shredded mozzarella cheese

A dash of black pepper

#### **Instructions**

- 1. Heat oven to 350 F.
- 2. Combine all ingredients well.
- 3. Bake in a small casserole dish in a hot oven for 20 minutes until bubbly.
- 4. Serve with wheat crackers, like Triscuits.

\*To make a Spinach and Artichoke Dip, add half a box of frozen thawed and drained spinach to mixture.


